We understand that Wellington has been stating or implying that they are working with the Teamsters or the Teamsters Canada Rail Conference to offer these services or that the Teamsters Canada Rail Conference or the Teamsters are endorsing or sponsoring your solicitations, your advice, or conclusions.


Any such reference, expressed or implied, that you are working with the Teamsters or Teamsters Canada Rail Conference or that Teamsters or Teamsters Canada Rail Conference are endorsing any of your activities or solicitations must stop immediately. The Teamsters and the Teamsters Canada Rail Conference do not in any way approve, sponsor, or endorse your solicitation of CPR employees, or the services or advice that you may offer; consequently you have no right to reference the name of the Teamsters or Teamsters Canada Rail Conference in any your communications, advice, or in any solicitation activity. To the extent that you have been working with or discussing these matters with local representatives of the Teamsters Canada Rail Conference, we advise that those individuals are not designated to act as spokesmen for the Teamsters Canada Rail Conference, and their views are not endorsed by the Teamsters Canada Rail Conference or the Teamsters. Finally, we advise that it is improper for you to suggest to CPR that the Teamsters or Teamsters Canada Rail Conference support or endorse your activities, (see for example your letter dated November 14, 2005); we demand that you refrain from making any further such references, direct or implied, to the CPR. We suggest in the future that you use extreme caution to avoid suggesting that the Teamsters or Teamsters Canada Rail Conference are in any way endorsing your activities or advice.
